

- Development over Winning
- Create Environment for Player Success
- Player Development Uniformity







- Reduce Advantage of Strongest/Fastesf
- Increase Technical Skills
- Ball on the Ground





PDI Mandate & AYSO

- US Soccer PDI's are for ages 5 to 12
- No change to AYSO Playground Soccer
- No change to Schoolyard Jamboree



PDI Mandate & AYSO

- Birth Year Registration
- Player Age at Competition's End = July 31
- Change Division Name, 8 and under (8U)
- Player can be no older than 8 between start of play in August and end of play on July 31




- 6U to 8U
- Size 3 Ball
- No Goalkeeper
- No Throw-in
- Kick-in, Pass-in, Dribble-In



- All Indirect Free Kicks for fouls
- No Penalties
- No Offside
- No Heading





- 9U and 10U
- Size 4 Ball
- Goalkeepers
- Offside
- Throw ins
- No Heading
- Build-Out Line







PDI: Build-Out Lines


- Goal Kick or Goalkeeper Possessic
- Opposing team moves beyond build
- Ball into play
- Also denotes offside line
- No punting












- 11U and 12U
