AYSO1103 Uniform Swap

Preliminary Guidelines

- Families involved need to understand that the inventory available may not meet their uniform needs. Inventory will be based on what has been turned in. If we do not have the uniform size you need, you will be given credit.
- First come First serve bases.
- All uniforms that are being swapped need to be in gently used condition. If we are giving you a uniform, we need to be able to give out yours. No stains, rips, holes, Etc. All items submitted will be examined to make sure they fall within these requirements.
- Swap is available to every AYSO1103 player.
- Any child that has received a scholarship will automatically move to the front of the line for available uniforms. The person who was at the beginning will then be bumped back one spot.
