Extra Games (All Extra Teams)

- All coaches AND players will have ID Cards, and should be verified during team safety check
- All player rosters must be printed AYSO cards – no hand-written rosters allowed

Please remember that we are responsible to get our Region games covered, points are only earned on in Region games.

Points / Game Coverage

Games MUST be covered by Thursday at 9:00pm or they will be cancelled.

U8 and Below: Home team is responsible for their own game

- *Recommend team coordinators confirm coverage by Monday night, so if an issue there is time to get it handled*
- *If home team cannot cover the game, Team Referee Coordinator should contact away team to help with coverage*
- *If both teams are unable to cover, please contact Nayt (rra@laderasoccer.com) for help*

U9 and Above: Do not referee your own games (but bring your gear in case of a no show)

Teams must earn 20 points to be eligible for entry to the End of Season tournament (10 points for Area Play teams)

Referee = 3 points, Assistant Referee = 1 point
