Background & Policy

- 1. AYSO referees are volunteers who are responsible for the safety and fairness of our soccer games.
- 2. Regardless of their abilities or experience, referees are empowered to enforce the Laws the game.
- 3. Coaches, spectators and players are responsible for their own behavior. It is never acceptable to verbally abuse a referee before, during or after a game.
- 4. If considered necessary, complaints, criticisms or recommendations shall be directed to the Regional Referee Administrator.
- 5. Most of our referees are youth volunteers (minors under the age of 18). Public criticism, abusive language or abusive conduct directed toward a youth referee will not be tolerated.
- 6. Offending individuals will be subject to disciplinary action, including a 1, 2 or 4 game suspension depending on the offense or repetition of offensive behavior. In extreme cases participants will be expelled from our program. Participation in AYSO is a privilege, not a right.
