2026 Fathers Day Frenzy Team Invitation



Hello, Coaches!

AYSO Area 1U, extends an invitation to all Boys and Girls teams in divisions U10-U19 to participate in the 2026 Fathers Day Frenzy

- Scope:** AYSO Invitational – open to AYSO teams only from all Sections.
- When:** U10 – U19 B/G Friday (for local teams), Saturday, and Sunday, June 19 - June 21, 2026 (We play rain or shine)
- Where:** The tournament will be held at Royal oak Intermediate School for 10U-14U (303 Glendora Ave, Covina Ca 91724) and Walnut Ranch Park for 16U-19U (20101 Amar Rd, Walnut CA 91789)
No pets are allowed at fields.
- Who:** AYSO boys and girls teams in age divisions: U-19 (11v11) 15 players max. U-16 (11v11) 15 players max. U-14 (11v11) 15 players max. U-12 (9v9) 12 players max. and U-10 (7v7) 10 players max. All players must be registered to play in the AYSO 2024 primary season. Eligibility based on age as of December 31, 2024. AYSO Guest players will be allowed (3 maximum per team). Co-ed teams will be accepted in boys' divisions only.
- What:** Pool play tournament. Each team will be scheduled 3 games in pool play. The top teams will advance, based on Rules of competition, to the medal round on Sunday. All pool play games will be as follows: U10 – 2 - 20 min halves; U12 - 2 - 25 min halves; U14- 2 - 30 min halves; U16/U19 - 2 - 35 min halves
- Why:** The purpose of the Fathers Day Frenzy Tournament is to provide the players, parents and coaches of teams interested a safe, fair, and fun venue to continue their soccer experience during the spring. Revenue from the Fathers Day Frenzy Tournament will be implemented to provide equipment and other resources to the players and regions of Area 1U.
- Awards:** All players and head coach coaches per team will receive an Fathers Day Frenzy Tournament pin. T-shirts will be given to those who apply and return t-shirt form by June 6, 2026 Championship Head Coaches will receive a trophy. All semi-finalists and finalists will receive medals
- Entry Fee, Refunds:** \$650 for U-16/U19 \$625 for U-14, \$600 for U-12, and \$575 for U-10. A full refund will be issued if tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is given. Within 30 days of the tournament, we will only issue a refund if a replacement team can be found, less any cost to register that replacement team.
- Referee Fee, Refunds:** \$350, refundable within 14 days of the tournament, if referee assignments have been completed. Each team is asked to provide a qualified 3-person referee team to cover 3 games during the tournament.
- Rules:**
- Acceptance:** A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website.
- How:** The application deadline is June 6, 2026. Incomplete applications will be returned. All teams will be notified within 48 hrs. of the application deadline or receipt of application (whichever is latest) as to their status. Accepted teams will be posted on the AYSO Area 1U website, which will serve as notification of acceptance. Regions will not be permitted to switch or change teams once accepted. All teams not accepted will be notified via email within 48 hours of the respective division application deadline. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their complete application returned or to be placed on the waiting list.
- Team entry applications and all necessary forms are available on the tournament website. Please send 1 Region check that covers both the Entry and Referee fees, along with the Team Application, Team Roster, and Referee Information and T-shirt order from to the Tournament Registrar address below. Regional commissioner must sign application and team roster. Appropriate referee administrator must sign referee information form. See referee form for details.
