- 3. COVID-19 Contingency Planning
 - a. The Board discussed options for Fall season and timing of making next decision. Concerns expressed relating to balancing the following:
 - i. Ensuring no or minimal financial commitment by families in event season does not happen - National has not provided assurance of refund on national fee, which is collected with registration.
 - ii. Volunteer recruitment challenged when unable to have in-person event and lack of time to do so.
 - iii. Safety of volunteers even if restrictions ease, unrealistic to see successful in-person registration, and presents potential safety risks to volunteers and registrants.
 - iv. Contractual commitments UK Coaches and uniforms need to manage timing of obligations and contingencies.

 - ii. Explore alternatives to typical registration (including waitlist option)
 - iii. Will revisit potential schedule and terms of registration and fall planning at May meeting.
