- 5. Coach Admin (AH)
  - a. AH to send out an email to Coaches about
    - i. game card expectations
      - 1. numeric order
      - 2. both sides of the card printed
    - ii. quarter break protocol
    - iii. Coaches on side lines
- 6. DC reports
  - a. 19U / 16U (DB & AH)
  - b. 14U (NC)
    - i. still do not have a full schedule yet due to Area play
      - 1. Moving it to after Labor day made it harder
      - 2. Last minute HB decided to add extra 14U teams...
  - c. 12U (AG) see pre read
  - d. 10U (CT) under control
    - i. Girl's coaches all sorted
    - ii. Some Boy's coaches still need to complete training
    - iii. Need to review change from 2 coaches to "as many as you like"
  - e. 8U/7U (CB)
    - i. seems to be running quite well
      - 1. Coaches doing a great job on the field
    - ii. 1 team not picked up uniforms yet
    - iii. Need to follow up on Women's coaching alliance
- 7. Treasurer's Update (AW)
  - a. JR working on payments for LiveScan
  - b. AW to look into how best to use the debit card for such transactions
- 8. Ref report (TW)
  - a. Opening weekend went well
    - i. every game had at least center ref (just)
  - b. Another in-person training this coming Sunday (17 signed up!)
  - c. 11 new refs trained
  - d. New google form set up for ref reporting scores etc
    - i. Todd will test it this weekend
  - e. Appropriate shoes
    - i. Should be "safe"

- ii. but no guidance on metal or toe cleats
- f. Too many coaches on sideline?
  - i. B'game will allow more than two
  - ii. BUT only two actually coaching
  - iii. AH and TD also to remind coaches on location of technical area
- g. Protocol at quarter break
  - i. clock keeps running! this is not a break in the game.
  - ii. emphasize not leaving the field
  - iii. Have the kids call of who they are subbing for
- 9. Equipment (GR+TG)
  - a. For future meeting discussion
    - i. e.g. U19 uniforms
    - ii. Size 3 balls have not been holding air this year
      - 1. see this <u>link</u> for e-pump
- 10. Field Prep (LR+AR)
  - a. All seemed to work well for U10
  - b. Lining Cuernavaca on Thu/Fri an issue due to Softball usage
    - i. LR not able to get information on who is using field
    - ii. AG has also asked for this information (new system harder to share?)
  - c. Opening Franklin for practices was an issue at start of season
    - i. now seems to be resolved
- 11. Safety (JB)
  - a. Covid protocols may need to be adjusted to reflect local guidance
    - e.g. probably can remove / change
      - 1. outdoor mask requirements
      - 2. interactions with non-vaccinated individuals
      - 3. reporting close contact with person testing positive
    - We would still need to hear about Player / team / coach testing positive
    - iii. NC to finds out definitive local guidelines
    - iv. NC to update policy; JB to review; BC to post on website
