



Whew! I've registered!

Now what happens?



What's the Board doing?

Team formation begins approximately two weeks before registration closes and typically takes 4–6 weeks to complete. During this time, the Region Board also continues recruiting coaches and referees to help ensure teams are balanced and as many players as possible are placed.

When do the coaches get their teams?

This year, coaches will receive their team lists on July 30th.

What should I be doing?

We are always in need of coaches and referees, and we encourage you to consider volunteering. If interested, please begin completing the required certifications—details are available on the [Registration Information](#) page of our website. All families, regardless of volunteer status, should review [AYSO's Six Philosophies](#) and the [Referee Abuse Prevention Policy](#) to help support a positive environment for all.

When do the players get called?

Practices may begin on or after August 4, 2025. Coaches typically contact players within two weeks of team assignments to share practice days, times, and

locations. Practice fields may be located throughout Chino Hills.

It's after Aug. 1st, and my child has not been called. What do I do?

If you notice other teams practicing but haven't heard from your coach, don't worry—teams start at different times, especially the younger age groups. Some coaches may also be out of town. If you haven't been contacted by August 15, please reach out to your division coordinator via the [Contact Board Members](#) page.

What else does my child need?

The registration fee includes a complete uniform (jersey, shorts, socks), supplemental accident insurance, and a basic picture package. Families are responsible for providing shoes (preferably soccer cleats), shin guards (required), a properly sized soccer ball, and a water bottle.

How often are practices and games?

Teams generally practice twice a week, with optional Friday Night Footskills offered for 10 weeks. Games are held on Saturdays, beginning September 13, primarily at Chino Hills Community Park. Older divisions may also play at Grand Avenue Park.

Need a Refund?

Players withdrawing before August 15, 2025, are eligible for a refund, minus the non-refundable AYSO National Player Membership Fee and transaction fee. Refund requests must be submitted to the registrar at registrar@ayso779.org. No refunds will be issued for requests received after August 15, 2025.
