

Practice Space Options

To start the Fall 2024 season, practice spaces are assigned at Central Park and Rio Norte. A Google Form will be sent via email to all the coaches to sign up for preferences for location(s), day(s), and time(s). Practice space requests received by **11:59pm, Saturday, August 3rd** will be assigned based on a random order. Any submission after that time will be filled based on date/time submission.

Central Park

- Assigned spots between 4:30p to 9:30p Mondays through Fridays.
- In general, we want to save the earlier time slots for the younger kids, with the older divisions practicing between 8:00 to 9:25p.
- The City often moves our spots around during the season. You will be notified by email if our City-owned practice spaces move.

Rio Norte:

- Assigned spots between 4:30p to dusk Mondays through Fridays. No light available after dark.
- Parents are to park in the front lot and walk across campus to the fields.
- Hart High School District Schools are permitted for practice. Please do not attempt to practice at any of the other schools.
- **NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON ANY SCHOOL PROPERTY**

Other Options:

Saugus Union School District Elementary Schools may be used for practices, but each coach must schedule their times with each school. There may be a fee charged. Region 46 will not be responsible for those fees.

In general, all city-owned parks are permit-only parks. We may practice at these parks as long as they have not been permitted and rented to other entities.

City of Santa Clarita Recreational Facility Parking

The fall season at city parks is a busy time of year. Our youth participants enjoy various athletic pursuits on the fields. Safety is our top priority, which includes compliance of all parking rules and regulations. In an effort to ensure safety, please adhere to the following:

- Parking is allowed in designated parking stalls only
- It is illegal to park in red painted areas.
- It is illegal to double park.
- It is illegal to drive over and park on curbs, mulch, or grass.
- It is illegal to park in front of driveways and walkways.

We encourage you to **PARK** and drop off participating athletes by their designated fields, carpool, and allow extra arrival time. All of these options will help ease the parking problems at both parks and ensure safety. Parking lots will be monitored, rules enforced, and citations issued. Additionally, always drive slowly through our parks.
