-  I will not yell at my child during games unless they are words of encouragement.
-  I will not yell instructions during a game. Please leave the coaching to the coaches.
-  I will NEVER make a negative comment to or about a referee.
-  I will make sure my child has an ample supply of water during practice and games.
-  I will let my coach know in advance when my child will not be at a game.
-  I will be realistic with my child's abilities.
-  I will calmly, quietly, and privately discuss any differences I may have with the coach.
-  I will make sure to respect the rights of the neighbors of the soccer fields.
-  I understand that AYSO soccer emphasis is on fun, sportsmanship, rules, positive coaching, and player development.
-  I understand that scoring must be kept to a reasonable goal differential.
-  I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials, opponents, and opposing sidelines at every game, practice, or other youth sports event.
-  I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of personal desire to win.
-  I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
-  I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, alcohol and profanity and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
-  I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child and I will remember that the game is for youths and not for adults.
-  I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
