 - All send offs must be filled out that day/night
 - Cautions are reported immediately
 - Both Coaches take pictures of cards and send in if there are send offs, etc
 - Fill out the Google form about Send offs
 - As Refs, remind coaches to take photos in 16U and up
 - Parents/spectators must be to the left of the technical areas
 - Coaches/Team MGR and players are the only ones in Tech Area
 - Asst Ref to the Right of the Tech Area
- \circ Send offs
 - Violent Conduct 3 game min, up to 6 games for bad one
 - Striking, biting, etc
 - Lesser offenses should be excessive force pushing, holding, etc
 - Send offs may impact your ability to go to play offs (player cannot do playoffs)
 - Cautions may add up 3 total it may cause you to be out on next game
 - Cautions are cumulative
 - We may need to track it for 1463 (keep track of our send offs and cautions)
 - Be prepared to answer Q's from Area/Section
- Record your substitutions (docs say it is required)
 - Make sure there is even play time for all players
 - We do our best and record all subs
- Play offs top 2 teams for the area will play for the Championship (Boys)
 - For the girls, top 4 teams since there are enough teams
